STUDENT POPULATION

As of September 2017 there are 926 students in the school. The majority of our students are ethnic Chinese and their mother tongue is Cantonese. In addition, the school hosts an international student exchange programme. This year, two foreign students have been enrolled for one academic year.

QUALIFICATIONS OF TEACHERS

Over 97% of teachers possess a bachelor's degree. 52% of them have Master's degrees. All of them have received formal teaching training.
