LANGUAGE POLICY English is adopted as the medium of instruction in most subjects. An English-rich environment is cultivated with concerted efforts of staff communicating with students in English and daily English activities organised with the help of the Chatteris Native-speaking English Teacher and English Ambassadors. Themed English activities are also held by the English Society regularly. As well, there is a special interest class in Literature and the Debating Team led by the Native-speaking English Teacher. School notices and publications are issued in English.
