Organising local cultural tours or field visits relating to the CS curriculum	Sep 2022 – Aug 2023	\$30000	\$8480	20 students participated in a hand-carved sparrow workshop, where they had the opportunity to experience traditional Chinese culture. During the workshop, the students learned the techniques of hand-carving sparrows, which is a craft with a long-standing history. By actively engaging in this activity, the students gained a deeper understanding of the unique aspects of Chinese culture.
