### STUDENT POPULATION

As of September 2018 there are 904 students in the school. The majority of our students are ethnic Chinese and their mother tongue is Cantonese. In addition, the school hosts an international student exchange programme. This year, one foreign student has been enrolled for one academic year.

Over 99% of teachers possess a bachelor's degree. 54% of them have Master's degrees. All of them have received formal teaching training.
